## **Liquid Pearl Commercial Leather Cleaner**

Product Information and Safety Sheet.

Health Warning:

Harmful if swallowed. Irritating to the eyes, skin, mucous membranes and gastrointestinal system. Keep out of reach from children. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear safety glasses and gloves.

First Aid:

If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Drink 2 glasses of water and get medical treatment immediately. If on skin, rinse with water. If in eyes, flush with large amounts of water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.

Contents: Water (C.A.S 7732-18-5), Sodium Hydroxide (C.A.S. 1310-73-2), Alkylphenol Ethoxylate (C.A.S. 9016-45-9).

## **Liquid Pearl Professional Leather Conditioner**

Product information and Safety sheet

Inhalation, Skin contact, Eye contact, Ingestion; May cause (mild) irritation.

Non flammable

First aid measures:

Skin contact: Rinse with soap and water.

Eye contact: Flush with large amounts of clean water for a minimum of 15 minutes, lifting upper and lower lids occasionally. DO not rub eyes. If any irritation persists, seek medical attention.

Ingestion: If person is conscious, give 2 glasses of water to dilute the ingested material. Do not induce vomiting. Any material having entered the mouth should be rinsed thoroughly. See medical attention immediately.

Keep away from children

Use protective equipment: goggles and gloves and protective clothing.

Contents: Animal oils(CAS 8002-64-0), Siloxanes (CAS 63148-62-9), Water(C.A.S 7732-18-5)

Extreme care should be used when cleaning suede. It is difficult to keep clean and you should consult a professional upholsterer for cleaning tips. This solution contains oxygen enriched reverse osmosis water, detergent and white spirit/alcohol. No responsibility is taken for the application of this product.

## Liquid Pearl Nu-Buck Suede

To clean suede:

Rub the surface of the garment with a clean bath towel. This brings up the nap. You can also use a nap brush or a soft hand brush

Try to remove small dry stains... apply cleaner sparingly. Small stains that are still wet should be blotted up by putting a paper towel on it and a weight on top of the towel.

Stains may also be rubbed off with a damp towel and the cleaner. Allow the leather to dry before assessing your success. Repeat the process if necessary. Be warned though, gently does it.

If there are lumps of dirt or dry scuff marks that won't come off this way, try rasping them off with a fingernail file. Be gentle.

Contains: water, White alcohol, detergents (1/800).

Do not swallow. Keep away from Children. Wash off skin thoroughly. If in eyes, rinse for 15 minutes. If inhaled, move to fresh air area. If swallowed, drink copious amounts of water.
